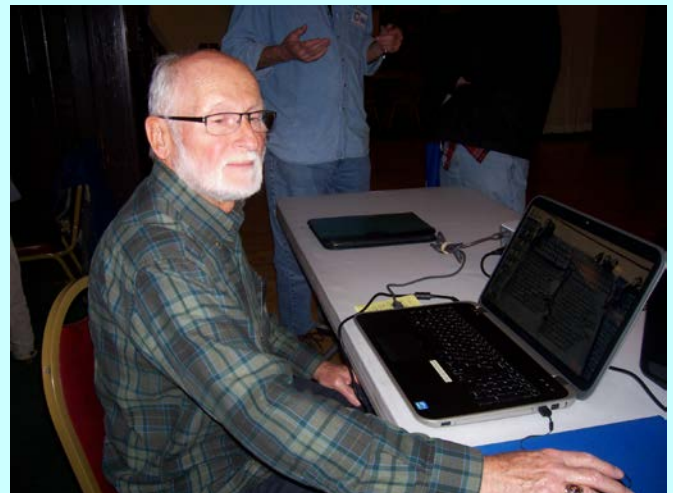

Dear Mary,

Thank you for your donation to the food pantry. Your donation enables JFS to assure that food, fresh produce and personal items will be available for people in our community who are having difficulty providing for themselves and their families.

People count on JFS's food pantry. In 2015, our pantry distributed food, diapers and personal care items to 383 households, consisting of 1160 people; 435 children, 578 adults under the age of 65 and 147 adults over the age of 55. Some use the food pantry once or twice during the year perhaps due to sudden family crises such as the loss of a job or unexpected health difficulty. Others use the pantry more frequently, requesting food assistance so that their limited funds will last through the end of the month.

Please convey our thanks to your fellow skiers at Ptarmigan Ski Club. We appreciate your vote of confidence in the work that we do. Your support helps make a difference. Thank you so much!
