LODGING OPTIONS and ASSOCIATED TRIP COSTS:

Telluride Mountainside Inn: The Telluride Mountainside Inn is located on the quiet side of the San Miguel River and 200 yards from lift #7 on the West end of Telluride. The Mountainside Inn Efficiency Hotel rooms are accessed from an interior hallway, and include a small table and chairs, phone, cable TV, free wireless Internet, fan and humidifier. The kitchenette includes a small refrigerator, 2-burner stovetop, sink, microwave, toaster, coffeemaker, dish soap & sponge, and cooking utensils. The Mountainside Inn features a common outdoor riverside hot tub, onsite laundry, vending/ice machines, and daily maid service. ALL rooms are non-smoking.

Riverside Condominiums: The Riverside Condos are located at the end of Pine Street, and situated along the San Miguel River Trail at the Bear Creek trailhead one block from Town Park. Typical 2-bedroom/2-bathroom units feature a livingroom with HD flat-screen TV and Blu-Ray/DVD player, stereo with CD player, gas fireplace, and doors that open to a semi-private deck with views of town. Many kitchens have granite countertops and full appliances. Common outdoor hot tubs throughout the complex and decks in each condo are sure crowd-pleasers. Lift 8 and the free Gondola are just two blocks away.

Tour participants shall ski at their own risk.**

CHANGE OF ITINERARY

Any changes in the itinerary will result in a \$100 change fee plus \$25 surcharge per person, and any additional changes as a result of the change – **IF the change is possible.**

AIRLINE INFORMATION

Traveler information submitted must be identical to the passenger’s Passport, or Government issued ID name (i.e.: no nicknames). Domestic flights require an exact match of a traveler’s name to his/her valid form of identification (i.e.: passport, etc). Seat assignments cannot be requested without names and are *solely controlled by the airlines* as group seating; once seats have been assigned to the groups, no changes will be allowed – special requests must be made in writing and are considered “pending” until confirmation has been received from the airline. *Frequent flier upgrades will be permitted only in circumstances where the carrier allows them, and are only obtainable at the discretion of the airline.*

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

Some restrictions and penalties apply to your vacation investment. If you cancel your reservation(s), **YOUR RIGHT TO A REFUND IS LIMITED**, as set forth in the following schedule. Date of postmark will determine appropriate policy:

- A: Any and all cancellations received 07/01/2017 to 12/01/2017 - \$300.00 per person contracted cancellation fee.
- B: Any and all cancellations received 12/02/2017 to 01/13/2018 - \$600.00 per person contracted cancellation fee.
- C: Any and all cancellations received 01/14/2018 to 01/31/2018 - \$1,200.00 per person contracted cancellation fee.
- D: Any and all cancellations received after 02/01/2018 = **no refund**.

No refunds for early departure or late arrival. No shows, no refund. No partial refunds will be made for car rentals, airfare, or unused portions of this package.
